Week Commencing:	Question/theme of the week at school and home activity
Throughout the year	<p>School</p> <p>Please allow your child to practise putting on and taking off their coat, zipping it up, removing and putting on their outdoor shoes and even having a go at putting on their woolly gloves!</p> <p>Our class target is to improve letter formation, if you have any spare time, please practise this with your child. We would also encourage you to listen to your child read their reading/ library book to you at least three times per week.</p>
2 nd May 2022	<p>I can make a healthy snack.</p> <p>With an adult, prepare yourself a healthy snack. This could be a fruit salad, vegetable sticks with hummus or a smoothie- the list is endless!</p>
9 th May 2022	<p>I can throw, catch, pass and kick a ball at a target.</p> <p>Play a ball game with your friends or family.</p>
16 th May 2022	<p>I understand how to cross the road safely.</p> <p>Practice crossing the road safely with an adult.</p>
23 rd May 2022	<p>I can say bird names familiar to my outdoors.</p> <p>Go outside and look for birds, can you identify and name any of them? What do they look like? Are they similar or different?</p>
