Week Commencing:	Question/theme of the week at school and home activity
Throughout the year	<b>School</b> Please allow your child to practise putting on and taking off their coat, zipping it up, removing and putting on their outdoor shoes.  Our class target is to improve letter formation, if you have any spare time, please practise this with your child. We would also encourage you to listen to your child read their reading/ library book to you at least three times per week.
13 <sup>th</sup> June 2022	Nursery: I can sing a simple song/ rhyme by memory. Reception: I can recite a simple poem.  Choose your favourite song, nursery rhyme or poem and try to learn it off by heart. Please upload this onto Tapestry.
20 <sup>th</sup> June 2022	I can tell you about my families' roles and interests. I can tell you about my families' likes and dislikes.  Bring in an item to show and tell the rest of the class.
27 <sup>th</sup> June 2022	I can tell you about my favourite book and the characters that are in.  Choose your favourite book and tell us all about the characters that are in the book. Do you know the plot or theme? You could record this on Tapestry or draw a picture illustrating it.
4 <sup>th</sup> July 2022	Find out about five a day- Can you make a poster explaining the five a day rule? What foods are healthy?
11 <sup>th</sup> July 2022	Share your favourite memory from your time spent in Emerald class.  We have shared many fantastic memories during the last year. Can you tell us your favourite memory in Emerald class? You could be as creative as you like!
