

Reception Weekly Focus

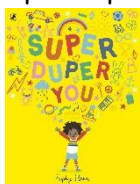
Week beginning 19th September 2022

Focus story: Super Duper You



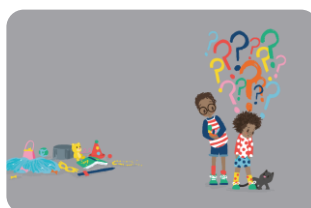
100 things to do before you're 6:
