This week in Literacy we will be identifying and matching initial sounds in words. We will be using magazines and newspapers to cut out different body parts to create a person. In Maths, the children will be comparing amounts and the size of objects.

Focus words: hunt, over, under, through

Talk about the words and what they mean. Can you use these words within a sentence throughout the week?

Focus story: We're Going on a Bear Hunt

Story Time: Retell a story using some of our focus words of the week.



Learning Enrichment:

Can you compare the size of your food cupboard items? (This could be cereal boxes, tins, packets etc). Which one is the biggest/ smallest? Which one comes in the middle? What other language could you use for bigger/smaller?

Maths Teaser: Can you describe where the bear is using positional language?
