Focus words: census, stable, appear, curious

Learning Enrichment: To retell 'The Christmas Story.'

Phonics:

Write the sounds that you have learnt so far. You could write them in chalk, pen, shaving foam etc.

Please listen to your child read every day.

Number of the week- 6, Six

Can you find this number in your house?

Can you show this amount using a resource?

Can you use this number in a number sentence?

Shape of the week- Pentagon



What does this shape look like? How many sides does it have? How many corners? Can you find this shape in the environment?

Maths Challenge:

There are 6 frogs on a log. One jumps into the pond. How many frogs are left on the log? Can you draw a picture to show the number of frogs?
