Dear Parents / Carers,

We would like to share with you what has happened in school so far this spring term and inform you of some future exciting events. Thank you to all our families for supporting our school this term.

Safer Internet Day was on the 7th February this year. The children took part in a range of activities aimed at promoting the safe and positive use of digital technology and how to use technology responsibly, respectfully, critically, and creatively.

Inspire Dance - Our year 2, 3 & 4 pupils are doing a great job in rehearsals. We can't wait to see them perform their dance routine!

Faith in Focus Week - We have been taking part in Biddulph/Biddulph Moors 'Faith in Focus' this week. The children have learnt about different faiths as part of their learning in the Religious Education Curriculum which also supports the government promotion of British Values (Tolerance and Mutual Respect). Each class have researched a different faith:

Emerald - Christianity Garnet - Buddhism Sapphire - Islam Amethyst - Hindu

On Friday 10th February for part of 'Faith in Focus' week, our year 4's visited Gita Bhaven Hindu Temple in Manchester and then enjoyed trying a variety of Indian foods at a restaurant in Chorlton. The children had a great time at the temple; they were very inquisitive and asked many questions!!! Afterwards they enjoyed the Indian buffet at the restaurant and some went up for 2nd / 3rd helpings! The children were very well behaved and represented the school wonderfully!

Change 4 Life Festival - Our year 1 pupils attended a Change 4 Life festival at Biddulph Valley Leisure Centre on the 9th February. The children all had a great time learning about a healthy lifestyle and mixing with other first schools from Biddulph. Well done for all the Year 8 pupils from Woodhouse Academy change for running the session.



World Book Day is on Thursday 2nd March. The children will be allowed to dress up as their favourite book character. Letter to follow with more information.

National Football Week – The children had a great time taking part in our lunchtime challenges, 10 pupils won a certificate and prize for the most 'wall kicks' and 'keepie uppies'.

Thank you for uploading your photographs of your children playing football with family members. One child won a football and a 30 minute football game with 5 friends out of lesson time. Great to see the children in football kits for PE!

Forest Schools - Garnet class have really enjoyed their 4 week block of Forest Schools. Thank you to all who attended the parent/ carer session. The next year group to take part in Forest Schools will be Emerald class on the 13th/ 20th & 27th March. Your child will need to bring in wellingtons; a waterproof coat; waterproof trousers or trousers/joggers you don't mind getting dirty and wet; and a hat and gloves.

Nursery Admissions - Admissions to our Nursery class needs to be made via the school. If you would like your child to start in our nursery class in September 2023 please let the office know if you are interested in a place, as application packs will be sent out shortly.



Holidays in Term Time - May we please remind parent/ carers that taking holidays in term time does have an impact on your child's learning. Can we please ask you to read our Attendance Policy on our website so you are fully aware of the implications of taking your child on holiday in term time.
