

Reception Weekly Focus

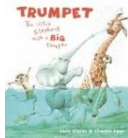
Week beginning 6th March 2023

This week in Literacy we will be reading the book 'Trumpet The Little Elephant with a Big Temper'. The children will be discussing the book and then using their phonic knowledge to write an alternative ending for the story. In Maths, the children will compare numbers up to 10 and learn the number bonds.

Focus words: **temper, wobble, waterhole,**

Talk about the words and what they mean. Can you use these words within a sentence throughout the week?
