This week in Literacy, we will be reading 'A Superhero Like You'. The children will be writing about doctors, nurses and paramedics. They will also be thinking about their future career when they grow up. On Thursday, we will have a special visit from a nurse who will be talking to the children all about their job! In Maths, the children will be learning about adding two numbers together.
