STICKY KNOWLEDGE

Infant baptism is when a baby is welcomed into the Christian faith.

During the baptism service, the sign of the cross is made on the baby's head with water or oil.

The child's parents are presented with a lit candle, which symbolises receiving the light of Christ.

An Infant baptism is held in a church, usually around a font.
