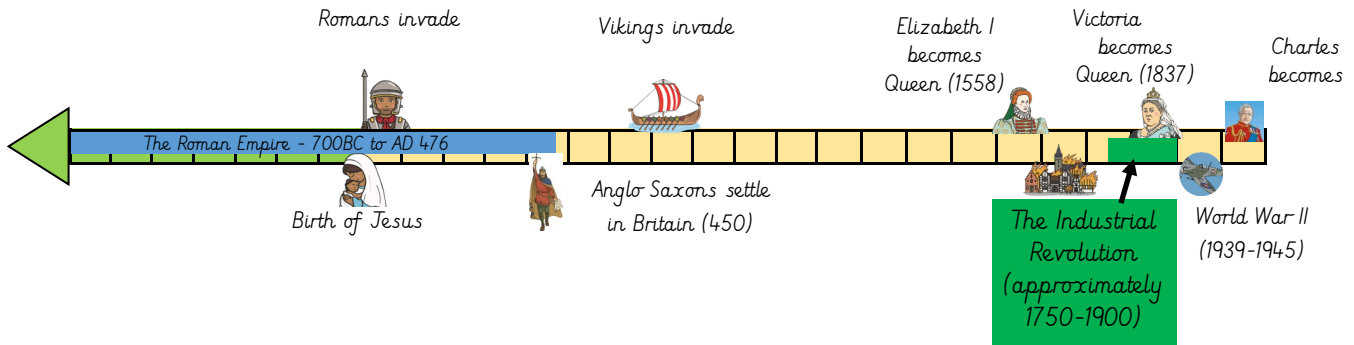
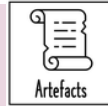
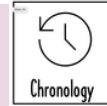


History: Local History of the Industrial Revolution

Engineer	A person who designs and builds machines, engines or structures.
Industry	Turning materials into finished products (often by using machines or factories).
Innovation	A new method or idea.

Colliery	A coal mine and all of the buildings and machines connected with it.
Urbanisation	When a population grows because people leave the countryside to move to towns and cities.

James Brindley designed the first major English canal which was built in 1761. He was one of the most significant engineers of the 18th century.



In 1857, Robert Heath created the Biddulph Valley Coal and Iron works.



The Biddulph Valley Railway opened in 1858, allowing for materials to be moved in and out of the area easily.
