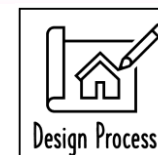


# WEAVING CONCEPTS



What should I already know:

Year 1: I can select appropriate resources.

-I can use language of designing and making.

-I can use simple tools and techniques.

-I can begin to use the skill of sewing over and under to make a running stitch with 1:1 support.

Year 2: I have my own ideas.

-I can design a product for myself following design criteria.

## Key Vocabulary

Template	A pattern or shape to use as a guide for cutting around.
Glove/ Hand puppet	A glove puppet fits over the hand and fingers.
Running stitch	A simple stitch consisting of a line of small stitches.
