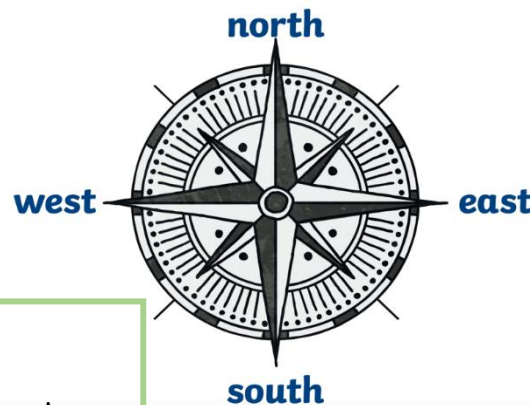


### WHAT SHOULD I ALREADY KNOW?

- Know my address.
- I can draw a simple map
- Y2-I can find the United Kingdom and one other country on a map.
- Y2- Identify and explain human and physical features.

### STICKY KNOWLEDGE

- A map can be used to help you know where to go.
- Symbols are useful for lots of reasons like, space saving on a map, multi-lingual (all languages can understand them), to save time and be clear.
- A compass is marked North, East, South and West.
- Human and physical features are things that you can see all around you.
  - **Physical features** like seas, mountains and rivers are **natural**. They would be here even if there were no people around.
  - **Human features** are things like houses, roads and bridges. They have been **built by people**.



### VOCABULARY

<b>Key</b>	A key explains what the symbols on a map mean.
<b>Distance</b>	How far away something is.
<b>Route</b>	How you get to somewhere.

Other vocabulary to know:

Compass= a tool for finding direction.

Map= a drawing of an area shown from above.

Fieldwork= Working outside to collect information.
