WHAT SHOULD I ALREADY KNOW?

What will I learn?

- I will identify the following physical features: mountain, lake, island, valley, river, cliff, forest and beach.
- I will identify human features, including: city, town, village, factory, farm, house, office, port, harbour and shop.

I will look at the coastal areas of the UK, using maps and photographs, and discuss the benefits of living near the sea.





A seaside has many physical features. Physical features are natural features, such as the sea, beaches, cliffs and different types of vegetation.

Human features found at seasides might include a pier, promenade, port, harbour and shops. These are all made by humans.



coast	The area where the sea and land meet.
harbour	Place where ships shelter safely
valley	A low area often running between hills or mountains

Other terms will also be explored, matched to photos/pictures and sorted into physical or human features.

cliff	Vertical natural wall of rock
Port	Place where ships load and unload
