

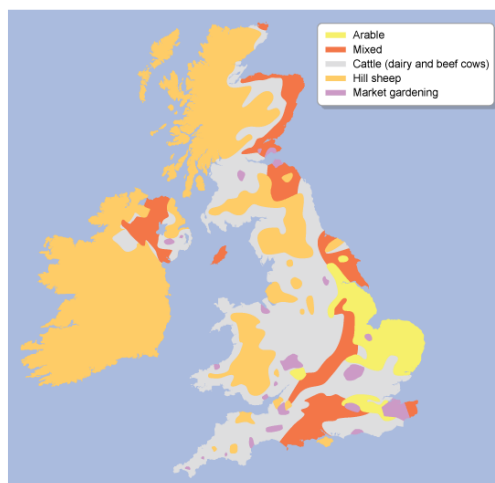

- Name the countries of and capital cities of UK.

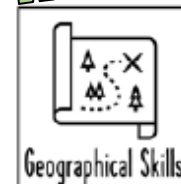


Sticky knowledge

- England is divided into 'regions' and 'counties'. Biddulph Moor is a village in the county of Staffordshire.
- Cities close by include: Stoke-on-Trent, Manchester and Birmingham.
- **Cities** and **towns** have a higher **population** compared to a **village** and have a larger area. **Transport links** are hugely important, so there are more **job opportunities**. Cities can allow a large amount of traffic in and out by **motorways** and **carriageways**, and **towns** can have easy access to these by **main roads**. **Villages** have a smaller **population** so these high speed roads are not essential. It can mean villages will have less traffic passing through and less options to navigate to surrounding areas.

Depending of the size of the location, you may also expect to see other types of transport systems: train stations, ferry boats, airports or bus stations.
