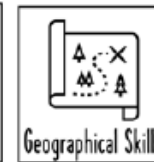

### VOCABULARY

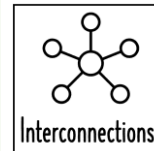
Africa	One of the seven continents in the world.
Non-European	A country that is not in the continent of Europe.
Comparison	To compare and find things that are similar and different.

**Other useful vocabulary:** Continent, country, location, human feature, physical feature, temperature.

Equator	Imaginary line around the middle of the Earth.
Climate	the long-term pattern of weather in an area.

### What am I going to learn?

- Africa is a **continent** made up of many different countries.
- I will be using world maps and globes to find a **country** in Africa.
- I will make **comparison** between **features** that are human and physical in an African country and my own.
- Being near the **equator** makes the temperature hot.
