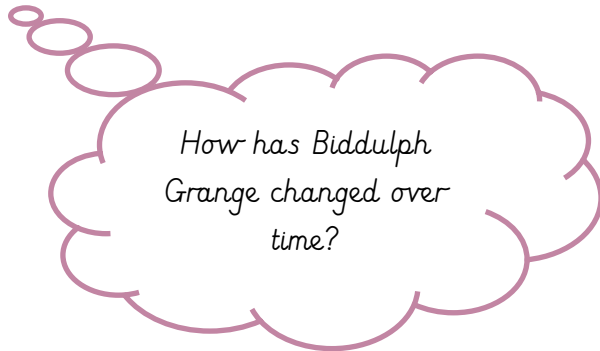

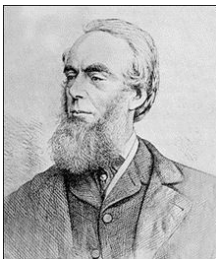


What should I already know?

In 1872, Robert Heath bought Biddulph Grange.

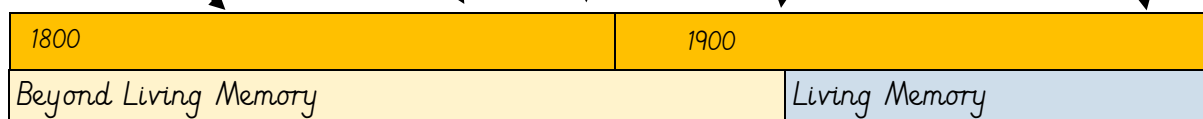


In 1896 a fire destroyed much of the house.
