- Christians feel they must care for the natural world as God created it.



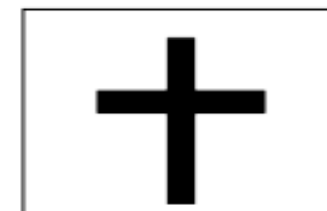
Vocabulary
