What should I already know?

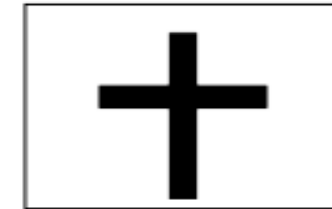
- I know that a Christian place of worship is a church.
